**Controlled Substances/Institutional Pharmacies -**

**Benzyloperazine** - Final rule of the Board of Pharmacy adopts regulations to classify N-benzyloperazine as a Schedule I controlled substance. The rule is effective March 6, 2009. Contact: Debra Billingsley; Board of Pharmacy; (785-296-4056)

**Dispensing Medications** - Proposed rule of the Department of Health and Senior Services, Division of Community and Public Health, would adopt regulations establish procedures for volunteer dispensing medications according to the Strategic National Stockpile Plan during a governor declared state of emergency. **OKLAHOMA**

**Pharmacies** - Proposed rule of the State Board of Pharmacy regarding pharmacies. The proposal would clarify pharmacy licensing requirements, change "OSTAR" to "Oklahoma Control Reporting," and allow board-requested inventory of pharmacies. The proposal also would clarify the patient practitioner relationship and describe "administration only" as it relates to hospital drug rooms.
