

NASCSA Resolution 2012-06 October 2012 Scottsdale, Arizona

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ALLIANCE OF STATES WITH PRESCRIPTION MONITORING PROGRAMS (ASPMP)

WHEREAS, the development, implementation and maintenance of prescription monitoring programs (PMP) provide a valuable resource for prescribers, pharmacists, federal and state regulatory entities, law enforcement agencies and research entities to assist patients and manage the prescribing and use of controlled substances and other drugs of concern; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to have an organizational voice to speak for the state PMPs to promote and assist ASPMP's efforts to educate and support healthcare, state, federal, law enforcement and research entities; and

WHEREAS, ASPMP serves as a means to facilitate and manage communications and data exchange among the states and other entities for a variety of programs and resources; and

WHEREAS, ASPMP embraces diversity and supports states' efforts to combat the epidemic of prescription drug misuse;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the National Association of State Controlled Substances Authorities supports the current mission of ASPMP.
