


32 states mandatory8 states pending

# NO DEA Mandate but DEA Requirements – 21 CFR 1300



Must follow State Laws which may be more strict



#### **DEA** Requirements if choosing e-scribe

**Third Party Auditor** 

**Identity Proofing** 

Two Factor Authentication Credentials

Hard Token

 Cryptographic Key stored on a device, cell phone, USB, etc.





# DEA e-SCRIBE REQUIREMENTS CONT.

- DEA requirements
  - Staff can fill required Rx info, but Practitioner <u>must</u> review before esigning
  - Must retain electronic records, min. two years
  - Information on e-prescription same as paper
    - Full name address of patient
    - Drug name, strength, dosage, quantity, directions for use
    - Name, address, registration of practitioner
    - Signature & Date of Practitioner using two-factor auth. credential





# LAWS & REGULATIONS

- HIPAA Exceptions
- Record Keeping Requirements
  - Usually satisfies best evidence
- Pharmacist Corresponding Duty
